**ONLINE ENTRIES ACCEPTED:** You can enter via AKC's ONLINE ENTRY Service at [www.akc.org/AgilityEntry](http://www.akc.org/AgilityEntry) and follow the instructions there to use your "My AKC" account to enter this event online. Initially 100 online runs will be provided, to be tweaked if changes are needed.

**DOGS ELEGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, have Limited Registration, or have an ILP, PAL, or FSS number. These trials are open to dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program, if spayed or neutered.

**JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS**

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. However, exhibitors are still required to have the jump height card with them at the trials.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Refer to the AKC website at [www.akc.org/events/agility/jump\\_height\\_card.cfm](http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm) for complete rules and policy regarding jump height cards and measurements.

**MEASUREMENTS:** Judge Jan Skurzynski is a VMO. If your dog needs to be measured before running, coordinate with Jan during breaks as far ahead of the time of your run as possible. Please be considerate as agility judges have very short breaks.

**COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/ WARM UPS**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without dogs prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm-up jump will be provided for each ring.

**PRIZES AND AWARDS**

Strip (flat) ribbons will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> place dog in each jump height in each class. The placement ribbons will conform with the colors set by AKC. Green qualifying strip ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title including MACH/PACH/PAX and will be presented to handlers finishing one of those titles during the event. MACH/PACH bars will be provided for anyone finishing those titles during the week end. All prizes and awards must be claimed the day of the trial. No prize/award will be mailed. All first place and new titles receive a special prize. Ribbons are self-serve.

**ABOUT THE SHOW SITE**

The Horse Arena is located on the campus of Expo New Mexico. It is climate controlled with a packed dirt surface. The dirt will be worked by a tractor every day after the end of that day's trial. There are lots of places for walking dogs outdoors.

**Crating/Seating:** Crating is limited and will be marked. Please crate only within the marked spaces. Crates may be left overnight; however, SDCKC and Expo New Mexico will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Security is provided by Expo New Mexico. Doors are locked at 8 pm and opened at 6 am. No dogs may be left in the building overnight. There are bleachers available for seating.

**A full service food concession** is available on the site. No "outside" food is permitted in the Horse Arena except for snacks at the volunteer table.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:**

**From 1-40 East:** Exit onto Louisiana Blvd. (Exit 162), and head south. Turn right (west) onto Lomas Blvd; turn left (south) onto San Pedro. From San Pedro, if you have a parking pass, enter the fairgrounds through **Gate 6**, the first gate on the left (the horse gate); otherwise, enter through Gate 3. Once inside the fairgrounds, the Horse Arena is in the northeast corner just past the Dairy Barn.

**From I-40 West,** exit San Mateo south (Exit 161 A). Turn left (east) onto Lomas and right (south) onto San Pedro. See above for the rest of the directions.

**EXHIBITOR PARKING**

**Day Parking.** All parking is paid; there is ample parking space near the arena. Expo requires a prepaid parking pass to enter at Gate 6, and they will not take cash for day passes at Gate 6. The parking passes are \$10.00 whether for one, two, or three days and allow unlimited coming and going. If you want a parking pass, you may send a check for \$10.00 made out to SDCKC to Nancy DaCosta, 13407 Desert Zinnia Ct. NE, Albuquerque NM 87111. Parking fees **must be received by November 14, 2018**, so we can get your passes to you before the trials. You must include a Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope. **If you do not send a SASE, you will not get your parking pass!** Expo allows you to purchase daily passes for \$5 a day if you go through the main gate (Gate 3). If you have questions concerning the parking passes, please email Nancy at [ndacosta4pak@gmail.com](mailto:ndacosta4pak@gmail.com).

**RV Parking:** There is plenty of RV parking, and it is first-come, first-served. Note that Expo RV parking is about half a mile from the Horse Arena. Fees are \$20 per night to dry camp and \$35 per night for hook-ups.

**Here's how it works for RVs at Expo.** Enter the grounds through Gate 3 at Copper and San Pedro. Go to the stop sign and pull into one of the parking lots you see. Call the number for the 24/7 security guard, **505-401-5095**, and he will come and meet you, take you to your site, and take your money.

**No overnight parking** will be allowed at the trial site other than RVs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**REFUNDS** No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. In the event of a judge change, a full refund will be issued to anyone wishing to withdraw before the opening of the trial. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. The Club will issue a refund due to a bitch in season being reported to the trial secretary and withdrawn no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

## CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for viewing at the trial secretary booth. None will be sold. Running order sheets will be available at no charge and posted online after closing with one copy posted at the trial site during the trials.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, LIABILITY:** Members of the Sangre de Cristo Kennel Club and their agents, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children and guests.
- SDCKC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against SDCKC or any official thereof.
- Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all of the obstacles safely.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) guest(s) and /or children. Those engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the site by a member of the Trial Committee. In such cases there will be no refund of fees paid.
- In consideration of others you will be expected to clean up after yourself and your dogs at the event site and at your motel. Failure to do so may be cause for disciplinary action.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** This event is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) a PAL number, a CPL (Canine Partner Listing) for Mixed Breeds or Approved FSS Breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.
- All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the event committee will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.
- **Faxed, telephoned, or unsigned, or incomplete entries cannot be accepted.** Entries not on the current official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. A maximum of 10 Entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the 10 dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee and are subject to an added collection fee of \$25
- **Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.**
- Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in chapter 11, section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and trial grounds. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup>** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

**Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner \_\_\_\_\_
